

After the First Reading go to the Altar, bow and then go the lectern. Do Responsorial Psalm.

Lector: **Send forth your light and your fidelity; they shall lead me on and bring me to your holy mountain, to your dwelling place.**

Lector: **Then will I go in to the altar of God, the God of my gladness and joy; then will I give you thanks upon the harp, O God, my God!**

Congregation: My soul is thirsting for the living God: when shall I see him face to face?

Lector: **Why are you so downcast, O my soul? Why do you sigh within me? Hope in God! For I shall again be thanking him, in the presence of my savior and my God.**

When finished go to the bottom of step, turn and face the Altar, bow and go back to your seat.
