We welcome Fr. Alexander Marquette to our parishes beginning July 1, 2025. He was ordained on May 31 at the Cathedral by Archbishop Bernard Hebda. He will be our new associate priest. You will also see Fr. Stephen Boatwright helping out at St. Michael and Divine Mercy in the future. He retired from his job and is widowed. He is 74 years old. He has been a deacon in the diocese for many years and is now ordained a priest. Fr. Boatwright lives in Apple Valley, MN and will be helping out at two different parishes. I will have them both write a bio about themselves in order for us to get to know them. We keep them in our prayers as Jesus did when He sent out His new priests into the world.

Since Jesus' priestly apostles are in the world and will be attacked by the world, Jesus asks the Father to continue protecting them as Jesus himself did while he was physically present with them. "The divine protection of the disciples recalls Jesus' words about his sheep: 'No one can take them out of my hand, ... and no one can take them out of the Father's hand' (John 10:28-29). Protected by Jesus, none of his disciples was lost except for Judas, the son of destruction. Judas's defection was not due to any failure of Jesus' part, but so God's plan, given in scripture, might be fulfilled (see John 13:18). Jesus' petition to the Father seeks not only to keep the disciples in communion with the Triune God but also to keep the disciples in communion with one another: "so that they may be one just as we are" (John 17:11).

In his prayer, Jesus makes three petitions for his priestly apostles: Keep them in your name (John 17:11); Keep them from the evil one (John 17:15), and Consecrate them in the truth (John 17:17). This third petition is characteristic of the liturgy and the priesthood. When something is consecrated or made holy, it means it is set apart from what is common and is now dedicated to the service of the Lord. "Just as the Father consecrated Jesus and sent him into the world, so too must the disciples be consecrated in the truth, meaning in Jesus himself, who is both the Father's Word and truth". Just as Jesus' consecration leads to his self-offering on the Cross, so also the consecration of his priestly apostles will lead to their self-giving and self-offering for the Church.




