## Divine Mercy Sunday

**April 12, 2026**

The Divine Mercy Indulgence is a special grace granted by the Catholic church, most especially connected to Divine Mercy Sunday, based on the revelations received by St. Faustina Kowalska and officially approved by the Church. A Plenary Indulgence is the remission of all temporal punishment due to sin.

Required actions: 1. Go to Confession within 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday. 2. Receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday. 3. Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father. 4. Take part in prayers in honor of Divine Mercy such as praying the chaplet of Divine Mercy in church or chapel or at least pray before the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved.

Interior disposition: complete detachment from all sin, even venial sin. Pray: Jesus, I trust in you.

For those not able to be at church. Pray the Divine Mercy prayers. Offer their suffering to the Lord. Go to confession as soon as you can.

A partial indulgence is given to those who: with a contrite heart, pray to the Merciful Lord. Perform works of mercy.

Indulgence is not automatic -the key is: a sincere heart, trust in the Divine Mercy, a feal effort to turn away from sin.

**This study will meet on Thursdays at 7:00 pm.**

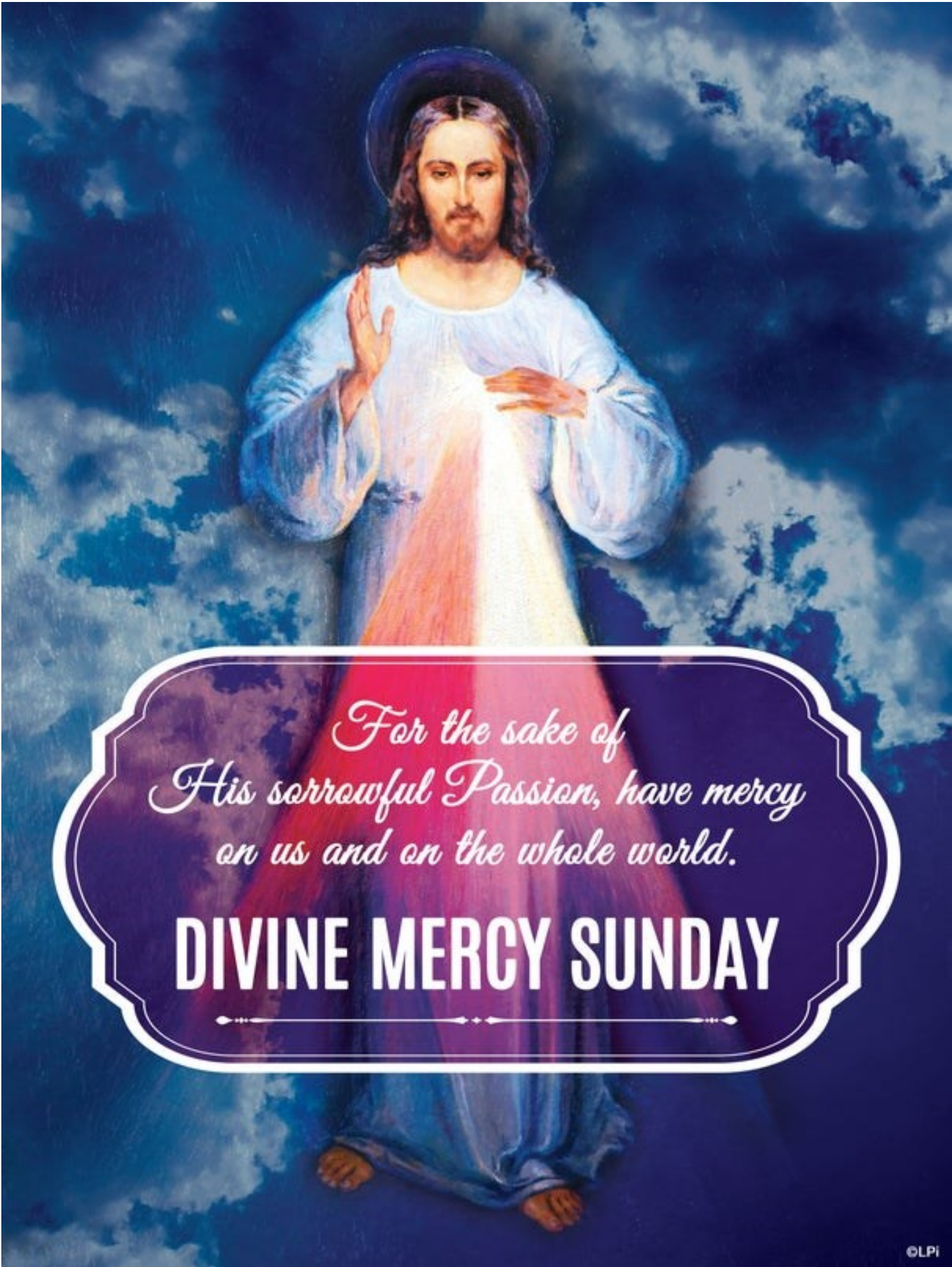
Eucharistic Adoration will be offered before each session from 6-6:55 pm.
